SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PERPETUAL, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT HEEIA, KOOLAUPOKO, OAHU, FOR THE EXISTING DRAIN, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

WHEREAS, portions of the existing drain seaward of the
property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 4-6-003:077, Heeia,
Koolaupoko, Oahu (subject property), were placed on state
submerged lands; and

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6 WHEREAS, in July 2009, the Board of Land and Natural 7 Resources authorized the issuance of an easement to the owners 8 of the private subject property for a dock that encroached on 9 state submerged land at the shoreline abutting the private 10 property; and

12 WHEREAS, during the process of approving the easement to 13 the private subject property owners, a structure that is part of 14 the City and County of Honolulu's municipal drainage system was 15 discovered within the state shoreline land area; and 16

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu confirmed that the drainage structure was constructed in the 1970s when the abutting land was subdivided and developed and, although the City and County of Honolulu obtained a drainage easement at that time for the portion of the system that encroached on private land, it did not hold an easement for the portion of the system that came to be located on state submerged land; and

25 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu agreed to obtain 26 an easement from the State for the portion of the drainage 27 system located on state submerged land; and 28

29 WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 8, 2010, under agenda item 30 D-15, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant

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of a perpetual non-exclusive easement to resolve the drain 1 encroachment, at gratis consideration; and 2 3 WHEREAS, at the July 8, 2010 Board of Land and Natural 4 Resources meeting, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Department of 5 Health, and Department of Land and Natural Resources' Office of 6 7 Conservation and Coastal Lands, Division of Aquatic Resources, and State Historic Preservation Division, along with the City 8 and County of Honolulu's Department of Planning and Permitting 9 and Board of Water Supply indicated they had no objection to the 10 request for a perpetual non-exclusive easement to resolve the 11 12 drain encroachment; and 13 WHEREAS, at the meeting of December 13, 2019, under agenda 14 item D-12, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved 15 technical amendments to the 2010 Board of Land and Natural 16 Resources approval to insert accurate legal references and to 17 18 facilitate the easement documentation process; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the total encroachment area was determined to be 47 square feet as reviewed and approved by the Department of 21 Accounting and General Services' Survey Division; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of 25 26 the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands; now, therefore, 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 29 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 30 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and 31 Natural Resources is hereby authorized to issue a perpetual, 32 non-exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged 33 lands seaward of the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 4-34 6-003:077, Heeia, Koolaupoko, Oahu, for the existing drain, and 35 for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements 36 37 constructed thereon pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised 38 Statutes; and 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 40 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 41 Board of Land and Natural Resources, the Governor, and the 42 43

- PURPOSE: To seek the authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution for the issuance of a perpetual, non-exclusive easement by the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) for the existing drain and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.
- MEANS: Concurrent resolution pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).
- JUSTIFICATION: Portions of the existing drain seaward of the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 4-6-003:077, Heeia, Koolaupoko, Oahu, were placed on state submerged lands.

In July 2009, the Board authorized the issuance of an easement to the owners of the private property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 4-6-003:077 for a dock that encroached on state submerged land at the shoreline abutting the private property.

During the process of approving the easement to the private property owners, a structure that is part of the City and County of Honolulu's municipal drainage system was discovered within the state shoreline land area.

The City and County of Honolulu confirmed that the drainage structure was constructed in the 1970s when the abutting land was subdivided and developed and, although the City and County of Honolulu obtained a drainage easement at that time for the portion of the system that encroached on private land, it did not hold an easement for the portion of the system that came to be located on state submerged land. The City and County of Honolulu agreed to obtain an easement from the State for the portion of the drainage system located on state submerged land.

On July 8, 2010, under agenda item D-15, the Board approved a grant of a perpetual, nonexclusive easement to resolve the drain encroachment, at gratis consideration. At the July 8, 2010 Board meeting, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Department of Health, and Departments' Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands, Division of Aquatic Resources, and State Historic Preservation Division, along with the City and County of Honolulu's Department of Planning and Permitting and Board of Water Supply indicated they had no objection to the request for a perpetual non-exclusive easement to resolve the drain encroachment.

On December 13, 2019, under agenda item D-12, the Board approved technical amendments to the 2010 Board approval to insert accurate legal references and to facilitate the easement documentation process.

The total encroachment area was determined to be 47 square feet as reviewed and approved by the Department of Accounting and General Services' Survey Division.

Section 171-53, HRS, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands. As such, this concurrent resolution has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of section 171-53, HRS. Page 3
