SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO WORK WITH THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY GARDEN ON THE EAST LAWN OF THE STATE CAPITOL.

WHEREAS, the State has committed to doubling local food production by 2030; and

WHEREAS, the State needs to utilize as many means as it can to realize this vision; and

WHEREAS, one such avenue is community gardens, which can strengthen community ties and produce substantial amounts of healthy, local produce; and

WHEREAS, the lawn on the east side of the State Capitol, which is located between South Beretania Street and Punchbowl Street, is currently underutilized; and

WHEREAS, the grass there requires significant maintenance, and yet rarely does it ever come into contact with significant numbers of the public, or those who work within the State Capitol itself; and

WHEREAS, it is worthwhile to convert the underutilized lawn into a community garden, which will serve as a piko between the Legislature, aina, and people; and

WHEREAS, by integrating food production and community onto the very grounds of the State Capitol, the Legislature will be re-affirming its commitment to sustainability, community, and transparency; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Accounting and General Services and Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested to work with the City and County of Honolulu to establish a community garden on the east lawn of the State Capitol; and
