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# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF MAUI TO AUDIT THE MAUI COUNTY FILM  
OFFICE.

1           WHEREAS, the Maui County Film Office was established in  
2 1994, as part of the Office of Economic Development of the  
3 County of Maui; and

5           WHEREAS, the mission statement of the Maui County Film  
6 Office is "to bring social and economic benefits to the citizens  
7 of Maui County through the inception, retention and thoughtful,  
8 meaningful growth of film, TV and new media"; and  
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10           WHEREAS, according to its website, the Maui County Film  
11 Office provides the following services:  
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13           (1) Film permit processing;  
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15           (2) Assistance in working with other authorizing agencies,  
16 such as the State, Maui Police Department, and  
17 Department of Parks and Recreation of the County of  
18 Maui;  
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20           (3) Online location database;  
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22           (4) Crew information;  
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24           (5) Support services; and  
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26           (6) Assistance with industry-related business development;

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29           WHEREAS, according to reports from the local film industry,  
30 the Maui County Film Office is difficult to contact and  
31 unhelpful when reached; now, therefore,  
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33           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second  
34 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024,  
35 that the County of Maui is requested to audit the Maui County  
36 Film Office; and


