SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES TO PROHIBIT RENTAL HOUSING REVOLVING FUND LOAN FORGIVENESS.

WHEREAS, the State's Rental Housing Revolving Fund (RHRF) 1 provides equity gap low-interest loans to qualified developers 2 constructing affordable housing units; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the RHRF is funded by state taxpayers, namely. 6 revenues from the conveyance tax and from general appropriations made by the Legislature; and 7 8 WHEREAS, these loans are very long-term (fifty-five years) 9 10 and low-interest (0.25 percent); and 11 WHEREAS, repayment does not begin until after senior debt 12 has been full repaid, often in year thirty-one; and 13 14 WHEREAS, developers may refinance RHRF debt from private 15 sector banks, repaying the RHRF early, but rarely do so because 16 17 they have no incentive to; and 18 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development 19 Corporation (HHFDC) may reduce the developer's RHRF debt service 20 payments if justified by the project's low cashflow; and 21 22 WHEREAS, HHFDC is permitted to forgive any remaining RHRF 23 debt; and 24 25 WHEREAS, affordable housing developers have no incentive to 26 repay RHRF loans in full; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, most RHRF housing is only temporarily affordable, and their owners are free to evict low-income tenants and rent 30 or sell their projects to the highest bidder after affordability 31 restrictions expire; and 32 33



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WHEREAS, over fourteen thousand units of affordable housing 1 will expire by the year 2100, many of which were subsidized by 2 RHRF loans; and 3 4 WHEREAS, RHRF loan terms are commercially unreasonable, and 5 state taxpayers deserve a better deal; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, forgiving RHRF loans to private developers amounts to a free gift of taxpayer funds to private entities; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, full repayment of these loans will enable the RHRF to create more housing in the future; now, therefore, 12 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 15 that the HHFDC is urged to adopt administrative rules that 16 prohibit Rental Housing Revolving Fund loan forgiveness; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director of the 20 Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation. 21 22 23 OFFERED BY: BESCO 24
