SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING MEMBERS OF HAWAII'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SUPPORT THE CEASEFIRE IN GAZA RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY UNITED STATES CONGRESSWOMAN CORI BUSH.

WHEREAS, all human life is precious and the targeting of 1 2 non-combatants in a conflict zone is in violation of rule 1 of customary international humanitarian law; and 3 4 WHEREAS, between October 7 and December 2, 2023, armed 5 violence has claimed the lives of more than thirteen thousand 6 Palestinians and some one thousand two hundred Israelis, and 7 wounded tens of thousands more, the vast majority of which are 8 civilians; and 9 10 WHEREAS, hundreds of thousands of lives are at imminent 11 risk if a permanent ceasefire is not reached and humanitarian 12 aid is not delivered without delay; and 13 14 WHEREAS, roughly half of the Palestinians killed or wounded 15 during the violence in Gaza are children despite international 16 humanitarian law requiring that all parties to an armed conflict 17 protect children and prevent the commission of grave violations 18 19 against them, including killing and maiming, attacks on schools and hospitals, recruitment and use of children, abduction of 20 21 children, and denial of humanitarian access; and 22 WHEREAS, these children and their families face further 23 24 imminent threats due to Israeli government restrictions on food, water, fuel, and other humanitarian assistance that reach them; 25 and 26 27 WHEREAS, the dismantling of Hamas, a recognized terrorist 28 organization, cannot and should not be achieved at the expense 29 of innocent lives; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, the United States federal government holds immense diplomatic power to save both Palestinian and Israeli lives; 33 now, therefore, 34 35

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 2 that members of Hawaii's congressional delegation are urged to 3 support the Ceasefire Now Resolution introduced by United States 4 Congresswoman Cori Bush; and 5 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of Hawaii's 7 congressional delegation are urged to insist that the Biden 8 9 Administration call for an immediate, permanent ceasefire in Gaza, to facilitate the de-escalation of hostilities to end the 10 current violence, promptly send and facilitate the entry of 11 humanitarian assistance into Gaza, including fuel, food, water, 12 and medical supplies, and begin negotiations for lasting peace; 13 14 and 15
