1 2 3	WHEREAS, Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole was born on March 26, 1871; and
4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, Prince Kuhio served as a non-voting delegate from Hawaii to the House of Representatives in Congress for twenty years, beginning in 1902; and
8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, his significant accomplishments include a \$27,000,000 million appropriation for dredging and construction at Pearl Harbor, the establishment of the Makapuu Point Lighthouse, the build-out of the Territorial building, the building of Hilo Wharf, the establishment of Hawaii Volcanoes National Park and Kilauea National Park, and construction of a hospital at the Kalaupapa Settlement for persons with Hansen's Disease; and
16 17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, Prince Kuhio also led efforts to convince the United States Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, under which the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands was created; and
22 23 24	WHEREAS, Prince Kuhio passed away on January 7, 1922, at his home in Waikiki; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, Prince Kuhio Day is a state holiday observed in Hawaii every March 26 to honor Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole; now, therefore,
29 30 31	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands is urged to display a
