Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1631, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HOUSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Require the School Facilities Authority to work with the (1)Department of Education to prioritize projects for the construction of educator workforce housing for teachers and staff employed by the Department of Education;
- Require the School Facilities Authority to include in (2) its annual report to the Legislature its planned actions to increase educator workforce housing; and
- (3) Require the Department of Education to collaborate with certain state and county agencies to submit a preliminary report to the Legislature on the status of lands designated to be transferred to the Department of Education pursuant to Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Education; School Facilities Authority;

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Housing Hawai'i's Future; Hawai'i State Teachers Association; aio; Hawaiian Host Group; Hawai'i Community Foundation; HPM Building Supply; Mana Up; Title Guaranty of Hawai'i; Democratic Party of Hawai'i Education Caucus; Holomua Collaborative; and three individuals.
