- (2) Appropriate funds to establish one full-time equivalent position within the Department of Education to manage the registry and carry out the requirements of this measure.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Education; Executive Office on Early Learning; State Public Charter School Commission; Hawaii Association of Independent Schools; Hawaii Council of Private Schools; and Punahou School. Your Committee received comments on
