Sir:

Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.R. No. 102 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTIES TO AMEND OR ADOPT AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, OR MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS TO DEVELOP RESIDENTIAL UNITS ON PARCELS THAT MEET CERTAIN CONDITIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the counties to amend or adopt an ordinance to allow religious institutions, educational institutions, or medical institutions to develop residential units on parcels that meet certain conditions.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation and Grassroot Institute of Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that with the severe shortage of affordable housing, the State needs to focus on innovative solutions to address housing demands. Your Committee further finds that there are certain institutions that are willing to build housing on their lands but are prohibited from doing so under existing zoning laws. This measure would encourage the development of housing throughout the State by allowing religious institutions, educational institutions, or medical institutions to
