Your Committee on Labor and Technology, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2287 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF ENTERPRISE
TECHNOLOGY SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to clarify the
duties of the Information Technology Steering Committee and the
required contents of the Chief Information Officer's annual report
of the Office of Enterprise Technology Services.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Office of Enterprise Technology Services and Transform
Hawai'i Government.

Your Committee finds that the coronavirus disease 2019
pandemic elucidated the fact that technology underpins virtually
every government service, and therefore it is essential for the
State to develop applications that allow the public to access its
services with ease. This measure will allow the Chief Information
Officer to receive assistance from the Information Technology
Steering Committee in developing a plan to enhance "hawaii.gov
mobile", the mobile application developed by the State for the
public to access the State's website.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:



- (1) Restoring the existing statutory duty of the Information Technology Steering Committee to assist the Chief Information Officer in developing State information technologies standards and policies; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Labor and Technology that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2287, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2287, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
