Your Committee on Health and Human Services, to which was referred S.B. No. 2460 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to appropriate funds to address the mental health and wellness needs of youth in the State.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Health Office of the Public Defender, Hawai'i Youth Services Network, YMCA of Honolulu, Catholic Charities Hawai'i, Hawai'i True Cost Coalition, Hawaii Medical Association, Mental Health America of Hawai'i, Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Opportunity Youth Action Hawai'i and seven individuals.

Your Committee finds that the youth of Hawaii face mental health challenges in more significant numbers than in years past, with depression, substance abuse, and suicidal ideation being top issues. Your Committee further finds a need to address the wellness and mental health of the youth in the State by funding resources with community-based services to ensure youth can gain the necessary tools to manage emotional, behavioral, environmental, financial, intellectual, physical, social, and spiritual health to develop into healthy members of their communities. This measure will therefore help provide increased

outreach and intervention to give the State's keiki the care they deserve.
