Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from Anamoda, Inc.; Natural Fibers Alliance; Fur Commission USA; Retail Merchants of Hawaii; International Fur Federation; American Fur Council; and one individual.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to June 30, 3000, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.


