SB 2545 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO RECYCLING. Amends recycling goals under the Electronic Device Recycling and Recovering Act so that goals are based upon the manufacturer's overall market share in the State. Amends penalties and definitions.	AEN, CPN/JDC
SB 3329 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LITTLE FIRE ANTS. Requires the disclosure of any little fire ant infestation as part of any sale of residential real property.	AEN, CPN
SB 2933 Status & Testimony	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO RECOGNIZE AND PROTECT THE INHERENT AND INALIENABLE RIGHT OF ALL PEOPLE TO CLEAN WATER AND AIR, A HEALTHFUL ENVIRONMENT AND CLIMATE, HEALTHY NATIVE ECOSYSTEMS, AND BEACHES. Proposes a constitutional amendment to ensure that the inherent and inalienable right of the people, including future generations, to clean water and air, a healthful environment and climate, healthy native ecosystems, and beaches, shall be protected and shall not be infringed. SB 2961 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WORKFORCE HOUSING. Requires the Department of Agriculture to establish an Agricultural Workforce Housing Working Group to address the shortage and challenges of agricultural workforce housing in the State. Requires a report to the Legislature.	AEN, WAM

SB 3025 RELATING TO HEMP. AEN, JDC Status & Repeals the requirement for additional rules by the Department **Testimony** of Agriculture to address nuisance issues, including smell, noise, and excessive lighting arising out of the activities of hemp growers. Clarifies that the Department of Agriculture will not require testing or sampling of hemp that duplicates testing and sampling required by the United States Department of Agriculture, but retain the authority to enforce other applicable state laws, such as Hawaii Pesticides Law. SB 3079 RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. AEN, CPN Status & Amends section 269-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to clarify that **Testimony** the Public Utilities Commission shall consider the effect of the State's reliance on fossil fuels on generation-based greenhouse gas emissions and may require a greenhouse gas emissions analysis for energy projects that do not result in generationbased greenhouse gas emissions. RELATING TO PESTICIDES. SB 3315 AEN, JDC/WAM Requires the Department of Agriculture to use consistent units Status & Testimony of measurement in its summary to the public on the amounts of restricted use pesticides used. Establishes a one-half mile buffer zone for pesticides around schools and state and county public parks. SB 3316 RELATING TO PESTICIDES. AEN, CPN/WAM Status & Requires monthly rather than annual reporting of restricted use pesticides. Amends the contents of reports to include specific **Testimony** geospatial data and information, site information, and increased detail on the amount of restricted use pesticides used. Requires the Department of Agriculture to develop an online reporting tool for restricted use pesticides. RELATING TO PLANT CARE COMPONENTS. SB 3365 AEN, WAM Status & Requires the Department of Agriculture to certify treatments performed on soil, dirt, wood chips, compost, and filter socks. Testimony Authorizes the Department to establish fees. Places certain restrictions on the distribution or transportation of plant care components without prior treatment certification from the Department. RELATING TO TAXATION. SB 3247 AEN, WAM Status & Creates an income tax credit for transportation costs incurred by certain taxpayers who ship produce and agricultural goods **Testimony** between counties. RELATING TO TAXATION. SB 3302 AEN, WAM Status & For taxable years beginning after 12/31/2023, creates an income tax credit for qualified expenses of eligible farmers, **Testimony** ranchers, and fishers. RELATING TO WATER INFRASTRUCTURE. SB 2814 AEN, WAM

Directs the Department of Agriculture, in collaboration with the

Agribusiness Development Corporation and the counties, to conduct a water infrastructure study for the State of Hawaii. Appropriates moneys. Declares that the appropriation exceeds the state general fund expenditure ceiling for 2024-2025.
