SB 116, SD1, HD1 RELATING TO SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES. CAI, FIN

(HSCR1172-24) Authorizes the issuance of special number plates to commemorate

Status Duke Kahanamoku. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

SB 3290, SD2, HD1 RELATING TO AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE. HLT/HUS, FIN

Requires the Disability and Communication Access Board to convene a working group to study the state of American Sign Language

interpretation services in Hawaii. Requires a report to the Legislature.

Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

RELATING TO THE OAHU REGIONAL HEALTH CARE SB 2837, SD2, HD1 HLT, CPC, FIN (HSCR1297-24) SYSTEM. HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION. Status Temporarily authorizes the Oahu regional health care system to oversee the operations and management agreement of the proposed state veterans home on Maui. Establishes a timeline and process for the permanent oversight of the operations and management agreement of the proposed veterans home on Maui to be reassigned to the Maui regional health care system. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1) SB 2345, SD2, HD1 RELATING TO CRISIS INTERVENTION. HLT, FIN (HSCR1272-24) Authorizes the Department of Law Enforcement to coordinate crisis intervention training for state and county law enforcement agencies. Status Establishes positions. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1) SB 2556, SD2, HD2 RELATING TO THE COMMUNITY OUTREACH COURT. HLT, JHA, FIN (HSCR1300-24) Permanently establishes and appropriates funds for the Community Status Outreach Court as a division of the District Court of the First Circuit. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2) RELATING TO ACCESS TO LEARNING. SB 2937, SD1, HD2 HET, JHA, FIN (HSCR1326-24) Repeals the sunset date for the exemption of laboratory school programs of the Hawaiian language college at the University of Hawaii **Status** at Hilo from state English-medium standards, assessments, performance ratings, staff qualifications, and staff training requirements. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2) RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER AT THE SB 3191, SD1, HD2 HET, JHA, FIN (HSCR1322-24) UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Status Permanently authorizes the University of Hawaii to continue to regulate conflicts of interest and other ethical issues for technology transfer activities sponsored by the University of Hawaii. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2) RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII RESEARCH. HET, FIN SB 3192, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1211-24) Makes permanent the Innovation and Commercialization Initiative Program established within the University of Hawaii. Takes effect Status 6/29/3000. (HD1) RELATED TO ELECTRONIC INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY. HET/LGO, FIN SB 2782, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1226-24) Requires the Office of Enterprise Technology Services to develop Status multilingual accessibility standards. Appropriates funds to establish one full-time position (1.0 FTE) to develop multilingual accessibility standards within the Office of Enterprise Technology Services. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1) RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF ENTERPRISE TECHNOLOGY SB 2287, SD2, HD1 HET, FIN (HSCR1161-24) SERVICES. **Status** Requires the Information Technology Steering Committee to assist the Chief Information Officer to develop a plan to enhance the mobile application developed to enable the public to access the State's website. Requires the Chief Information Officer's annual report of the Office of Enterprise Technology Services to include updates on the mobile

application. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

SB 3305, HD2 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDN, JHA, FIN (HSCR1250-24) Requires all public charter schools that exclusively offer prekindergarten programs to adhere to the public charter school law, Status with certain exceptions. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2) SB 2257, SD3, HD1 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDN, FIN (HSCR1114-24) Authorizes the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board to consider qualified individuals with at least an associate's degree or high school diploma Status with comparable education and coursework, industry experience, and content expertise to teach career and technical education courses. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1) SB 2070, SD1, HD1 RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. EDN/LGO, FIN (HSCR1263-24) Exempts career and technical education goods and services purchases Status by the Department of Education from the State Procurement Code. Requires the Department of Education to acquire three verbal or written quotes for career and technical education purchases of no more than \$100,000. Requires awards of over \$2,500 for career and technical education purchases to comply with certain statutory provisions regarding offerors. Requires awards of over \$500,000 for career and technical education purchases to be approved by the Superintendent of Education. Repeals 7/1/2027. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1) SB 3207, SD2, HD1 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDN, FIN (HSCR1118-24) Removes the salary cap of Superintendent of Education. Makes permanent the annual performance evaluation requirements for the Status Superintendent of Education. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

SB 2475, SD2, HD2 (HSCR1321-24) Status

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

Establishes a harm to students registry, for all early learning programs or schools and K-12 educational institutions within the State, that contains information on school employees, contractors, or volunteers for whom, as result of an investigation, a final finding has been issued that the individual has inflicted harm on a student. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)
