Status & Authorizes a state department, division, or agency, rather than the Department of Human Resources Development, to conduct a minimum qualification review of applicants for vacant positions

within the department, division, or agency. Requires the Department of Human Resources Development to provide state departments, divisions, and agencies the applications received for vacancies under certain circumstances. Effective 7/1/3000.

(HD1)

HB 2696, HD1 RELATING TO LAHAINA WILDFIRE RECOVERY.

(HSCR840-24) Establishes the Lahaina Recovery Oversight Commission within the Department of Accounting and General Services to oversee and guide the recovery of Lahaina from the 2023 wildfires.

Testimony Requires the Office of Enterprise Technology Services to assist

in establishing a website for the Commission. Requires annual reports. Appropriates moneys. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

HB 1645, HD1 RELATING TO STATE POSITION VACANCIES.

(HSCR810-24)
Requires the Department of Human Resources Development to include information and data on the vacancies of the executive branch in its annual report to the legislature. Appropriates

Testimony funds. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
