| HB 2112, HD2<br>(HSCR911-24)<br>Status &<br>Testimony | RELATING TO MOPED INSURANCE.<br>Requires that moped operators carry an insurance policy by<br>incorporating mopeds into the insurance laws governing<br>motorcycles and motor scooters, including with respect to<br>provisions concerning required licensure, the relationship with<br>tort law, proof of insurance card, penalties, rate regulation, and<br>minimum coverage levels. | HB 1932, HD2<br>(HSCR965-24)<br>Status &<br>Testimony | RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.<br>Authorizes the Department of Transportation to acquire,<br>including by condemnation, any real, personal, or mixed<br>property for immediate or future use and own, hold, improve,<br>rehabilitate, sell, assign, exchange, transfer, convey, lease, or<br>dispose of the property acquired. Amends the definition of<br>"public lands" to exclude lands to which the Department of<br>Transportation holds title. | HB 2526, HD2<br>(HSCR1055-24)<br>Status &<br>Testimony                  | RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.<br>Increases the penalty for a third or subsequent offense involving<br>the unauthorized driving or operation of motor vehicles to a<br>class C felony. Authorizes the court, as part of the person's<br>sentencing for the third or subsequent offense, to order that the<br>vehicle used by the person in the commission of the offense be<br>subject to forfeiture. Effective 1/1/3000. (HD2) | TCA, JDC     |
