<u>SB 2203</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LAND USE COMMISSION. Applies permissible uses within agricultural districts to counties having specific population levels.	WTL/EET, WAM
<u>SB 2789</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO LAND USE. Permits film production on lands that are zoned for agricultural use. Establishes the Agricultural Film Production Land Use Oversight Committee to monitor and enforce compliance with regulations on film permit activities on agricultural zoned lands.	WTL/EET, JDC
<u>SB 3060</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO A CLIMATE ADAPTION AND RESILIENCE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN. Requires the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development to develop and publish a statewide climate adaptation and resilience implementation plan.	WTL/EET, WAM
<u>SB 2811</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL TOURISM. Makes state agricultural tourism requirements applicable to all counties, instead of only counties that have adopted an agricultural tourism ordinance. Requires Land Use Commission to adopt rules that establish requirements applicable to all farms implementing agricultural tourism.	WTL/EET, WAM

<u>SB 2659</u>

Status & Testimony RELATING TO REGENERATIVE TOURISM.

Incorporates a regenerative framework into the State Planning Act by expanding objectives and policies for the visitor industry. Requires an update to the State Tourism Functional Plan to be submitted to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
