- 1 **Fiscal Implications:** This measure will impact the priorities identified in the Governor's
- 2 Executive Budget Request for the Department of Health's (Department's) appropriations and
- 3 personnel priorities. If implemented as proposed, the Department will require additional
- 4 positions to be established and funded.
- 5 **Department Testimony:** This measure removes a number of exemptions and requires all deposit
- 6 beverage container dealers to operate a redemption center. The Department offers the following
- 7 comments.
- 8 Upon the measure's effective date, hundreds of dealers, including vending machines and dealers
- 9 that are located near existing redemption centers, will immediately be required to be newly
- 10 certified redemption centers. While we believe that this proposal will significantly increase
- 11 consumer access to redemption centers, we also recognize that this requirement could be a
- financial or logistical hardship for some businesses, as equipment, space and labor will be
- required to operate a redemption center. This statutory change may also result in an over-
- saturation of redemption centers.
- 15 With the increasing number of redemption centers, the Department will require additional
- resources to issue permits and certifications, conduct inspections, issue and manage contracts,
- and pay invoices from the redemption centers.

- 1 In addition, as the measure becomes effective upon approval, and no implementation date is
- 2 provided in the measure itself, we recommend that the Legislature allow time for dealers to
- 3 develop a plan for a redemption center, negotiate leases, enter contracts with recyclers, obtain
- 4 necessary permits and certifications, purchase equipment, and hire staff.
