HB 2500 – RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CONFERENCE CENTER REVOLVING FUND

Chair Perruso, Vice Chair Kapela, and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to present testimony today. The University of Hawai'i (UH) **supports** HB 2500, Relating to University of Hawaii Conference Center Revolving Fund. This bill establishes the University of Hawaii Conference Center Revolving Fund by amending existing duplicative statutes so that a singular revolving fund can be utilized by all campuses within the University of Hawai'i System. The bill would permit the administration of a revolving fund for conference center programs among various campuses and operating units of the UH System.

Current statute provides for Conference Center Revolving Funds for the UH Community Colleges and UH-Hilo. This bill would create one UH Conference Center Revolving Fund and each campus would have accounts within this overarching fund. The authorization of a single revolving fund would allow all campuses to standardize fiscal management of conference center programs across all campuses while eliminating unnecessary duplication of statutes. This structure is similar to many other UH funds, including the Tuition and Fees Special Fund, the Auxiliary Enterprises Special Fund, and the Student Activities Revolving Fund.
