<u>DEPARTMENT'S POSITION</u>: The Department of Human Services (DHS) appreciates the intent of this resolution, defers to the Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS), and provides comments.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this resolution is to request the Lieutenant Governor to establish a working group to consider providing child care services at the Hawaii State Capitol.

DHS appreciates the Legislature's interest in making child care services available at the Hawaii State Capitol so that members of the public and legislative employees may be able to access child care while participating in the legislative process or while working at the capitol building.

DHS supports the request by the Legislature to establish a working group to evaluate the opportunities for child care services at the capitol, determine the resources and funding that may be necessary to provide the child care services and assess the areas within the capitol that could be used to provide the services. DHS recommends that a representative from its child

care program and the Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) be invited to participate in the workgroup.

DAGS may be able to guide the feasibility and costs of any renovations to make spaces conducive to child care operations that are provided in healthy and safe child care settings. DHS, a regulatory agency of child care facilities, is able to offer comments on the location of the child care classroom, sufficient space for the number of children in care at the facility, toilet facilities, provisions for meals and snacks for children in care, appropriate outdoor space for the children to engage in activities, ways to minimize risk or prevent access to hazards on the property, provisions for safe drop-off and pick-up areas for children by their families, and other related health and safety matters to consider when operating a child care facility.
