### SB 2645, SD1, RELATING TO COMPLIANCE ON HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS

Aloha Chairs Dela Cruz and Rhoads, Vice Chairs Moriwaki and Gabbard, and Members of the Committees:

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) strongly supports this bill which 1) establishes a compliance and enforcement program within the DHHL to investigate complaints, conduct investigations, and cooperate with enforcement authorities to ensure compliance with laws; 2) declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded; and 3) makes an appropriation.

DHHL considers the health and safety of homestead communities to be a top priority. Illegal activity occurring on Hawaiian Home Lands (HHL) threatens the health and safety of the community. Responses to these issues by law enforcement, however, are inconsistent across the different counties. DHHL supports better coordination between state and county law enforcement, and sufficient enforcement personnel dedicated to HHL.

Funds appropriated to the DHHL for the compliance and enforcement program would be used to fill at least five (5) FTE positions, as well as resources for training and equipment. The DHHL manages a little over 200,000 acres of land and much of which is located on neighbor islands such as Hawai'i island. Many beneficiaries who reside on HHL on the neighbor islands have expressed a strong desire to have compliance and enforcement program personnel who can reside and serve on their respective islands, and quickly and efficiently address beneficiary concerns with a keen understanding of the homestead communities that they are meant to serve.
