## Testimony COMMENTING on SB3341 RELATING TO REUSABLES

- 1 Fiscal Implications: This measure will impact the priorities identified in the Governor's
- 2 Executive Budget Request for the Department of Health's (Department) appropriations and
- 3 personnel priorities.
- 4 **Department Testimony:** The Department respectfully provides comments on SB3341, which
- 5 establishes the "Upcycled Mobile Dishwashing System Pilot Program" within the Department
- 6 and provides two full-time positions in support of the pilot program.
- 7 The Department supports opportunies to increase reuse and decrease waste generation, however,
- 8 the Department is unclear as to what an "upcycled mobile dishwashing system" or "circular
- 9 reuse dishwashing system" entails or what the ultimate purpose of the system or program would
- be. Based on the intent and purpose of the upcycled mobile dishwashing system, the Department
- may or may not be the appropriate agency to facilitate such a program. Without a general
- understanding of the intent of the program, the Department is further unable to identify what
- impacts implementation of such a program would have on Departmental priorities. In addition, it
- is unclear as to what or how the Department is to establish a "committee-appointed consultant
- position" who will work with the Department to manage and implement the proposed pilot
- program or what a "developer to design a reuseable certification program" requires. Establishing
- 17 positions is a state personnel action that must follow human resource requirements, policies and
- 18 guidance.

- 1 The lack of a clear understanding about multiple aspects of SB3341 prevents the Department
- 2 from either supporting or opposing the proposed bill. The Department would welcome future
- 3 discussions on the topic of the bill to determine the appropriateness of the Department's
- 4 involvement.
