<u>**DEPARTMENT'S POSITION**</u>: The Department of Human Services (DHS) provides comments on this measure, requests clarification as to its purpose, and respectfully requests that the measure be deferred.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: This bill establishes the Compacts of Free Association Census Task Force within the Department of Human Services to conduct a census of COFA residents in Hawaii.

DHS requests clarification of the purpose of this measure as federal entities have conducted both census and analysis of the population of residents in Hawaii, US territories, and several states. The US Census Bureau conducts the census of Hawaii residents, including those residents from member nations of the Compacts of Free Association. In addition, in June 2020, the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) released its comprehensive Report to the Chairman of the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources, U.S. Senate, COMPACTS OF FREE ASSOCIATION, Populations in U.S. Areas Have Grown, with Varying Reported Effects, (GAO-20-491). DHS participated in GAO's investigation and found the process thorough and fair.

DHS respectfully asks the Legislature to consider the findings of the GAO's report instead of formulating a task force. DHS provides benefits and services to eligible Hawaii residents; DHS does not have available staff to facilitate this workgroup, nor does it have the expertise to guide the requested work. Therefore, DHS respectfully requests that this measure be deferred.
