Services supported by this grant will enable our business to expand coverage in the ranch, farm, and overall agriculture sectors. They include, 24 hour patrols via all terrain vehicles, motorized vehicles, drones, and on foot to deter and detect any unauthorized access or suspicious activities. Securing private property, maintaining a visible presence to enhance the overall security of the property, reporting and collaborating with law enforcement to protect agriculture via ranch and farm lands. Funding will ensure continuity of daily operations.

Helping to ensure that Hawaii's ranches, farms, and landscapes can operate in a safe capacity requires agriculture security from regular theft and crime that targets our State's most vulnerable economic populations: Our agricultural fields, warehouses, and farmers. Our request will help to achieve increased patrols from unauthorized or suspicious activity, maintain a visible presence of property, protect ag production facilities, flower farms, vegetable fields, lo'i kalo, loko i'a, and livestock areas, all while treating people with respect, and aloha.

The Target we aim to serve consists of local farmers, ranchers, and agricultural business owners in Hawai'i.

Current operations exist in Windward O'ahu, eventual expansion is planned throughout FY27-28.


