Report to the Legislature: Early Learning Special Fund August 29, 2025

Context

The Early Learning Special fund was originally established as the Keiki First Steps Trust Fund pursuant to Act 14, SSLH 2008. It was administered by the Early Learning Council to support the early learning system in the State of Hawai'i.

In 2009, pursuant to Act 194, SLH 2009, the Keiki First Steps Trust Fund was renamed the Early Learning Trust Fund. The Early Learning Trust Fund was subsequently moved under the administration of the Executive Office on Early Learning (EOEL) after the office was established by Act 178, SLH 2012.

In 2020, Act 46, SLH 2020 (Act 46), changed the fund to a special fund and renamed it the Early Learning Special Fund. Act 46 also added a reporting requirement, directing the EOEL to submit an annual report to the Legislature on the sources of money deposited into the Early Learning Special Fund, and expenditures made from the Fund, no later than August 31 of each year.

Early Learning Special Fund Report for FY 2024-25

The revenues deposited into the Early Learning Special Fund in FY 2024-25 were as follows:
