A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY INDUSTRY INFORMATION REPORTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 486J-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§486J-5.5 Energy data collection program. The department
4 shall establish the energy data collection program that includes
5 development and maintenance of an energy database system that
6 meets the requirements of government and industry, while
7 promoting sound policy making, greenhouse gas emission inventory
8 reporting, energy planning, energy assurance planning, [~~and~~]
9 energy security[~~-~~], critical infrastructure protection, and
10 emergency management, response, and recovery."

11 SECTION 2. Section 486J-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 "(c) Unless otherwise provided by law, with respect to
14 data that the commission or department obtained or was provided
15 pursuant to this chapter, neither the commission or department
16 nor any employee of the commission or department may do any of
17 the following:

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- 1 (1) Use the information furnished or obtained for any
2 purpose other than the purposes for which it is
3 supplied;
- 4 (2) Make any publication whereby the data furnished by any
5 person can be identified; or
- 6 (3) Permit any person other than the commission, the
7 department of taxation, the attorney general, the
8 consumer advocate, the department of business,
9 economic development, and tourism, the department of
10 health, the Hawaii emergency management agency, the
11 office of homeland security, and the authorized
12 representatives and employees of each to examine the
13 individual reports or statements provided."

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


