## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the school
- 2 facilities authority was established to oversee the development,
- 3 planning, and construction of public school facilities across
- 4 the State, ensuring that schools meet the infrastructure needs
- 5 of students, staff, and communities. Presently, the school
- 6 facilities authority board consists of five voting members
- 7 appointed by the governor.
- **8** The department of education is a necessary and critical
- 9 partner to the successful implementation of school facilities
- 10 projects through its understanding of educational needs and
- 11 administrative priorities. There is a need to strengthen
- 12 collaboration between the department of education and the school
- 13 facilities authority to ensure that the planning and development
- 14 of school facilities are aligned with the educational goals and
- 15 requirements of Hawaii's public education system.
- 16 The legislature further finds that the board of education,
- 17 which oversees the department of education, brings a perspective

- 1 on educational governance and policy. Incorporating
- 2 representatives from the department of education and board of
- 3 education as ex officio voting members of the school facilities
- 4 authority board will ensure the department of education's
- 5 strategic priorities are represented in the school facilities
- 6 authority's projects and enhance the accountability and
- 7 responsiveness of the school facilities authority to the needs
- 8 of students, educators, and the community.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to add two ex
- 10 officio voting members that represent the department of
- 11 education and the board of education to the school facilities
- 12 authority board.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1704, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) The board shall consist of [five] seven voting
- 16 members[. The] who shall serve without compensation but may be
- 17 reimbursed for expenses, including travel expenses, necessary
- 18 for the performance of their duties; provided that:
- 19 (1) Five of the members shall:
- 20  $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$  (A) Be appointed by the governor pursuant to
- 21 section 26-34;
