
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL CANNABIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 329-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Primary caregivers shall register with the department
4 of health. ~~[Every]~~ A primary caregiver ~~[shall]~~ may be
5 responsible for the care of ~~[only]~~ more than one qualifying
6 patient at any given time~~[, unless the primary caregiver is the~~
7 ~~parent, guardian, or person having legal custody of more than~~
8 ~~one minor qualifying patient, in which case the primary~~
9 ~~caregiver may be responsible for the care of more than one minor~~
10 ~~qualifying patient at any given time; provided that the primary~~
11 ~~caregiver is the parent, guardian, or person having legal~~
12 ~~custody of all of the primary caregiver's qualifying patients]~~.
13 The department of health may permit registration of up to two
14 primary caregivers for a minor qualifying patient; provided that
15 both primary caregivers are the parent, guardian, or person
16 having legal custody of the minor qualifying patient."

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
4 provided that on June 30, 2030, this Act shall be repealed and
5 section 329-123(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted
6 in the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective
7 date of this Act.
