
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 206N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§206N- Wireless telecommunications carriers; backup
5 power. (a) As a condition for any permit under section 206N-6
6 for a wireless telecommunications carrier to construct,
7 reconstruct, or alter a telecommunications facility, the
8 telecommunications facility shall maintain emergency backup
9 power for a minimum of twelve hours.

10 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit
11 the public utilities commission's authority to regulate wireless
12 telecommunications carriers under chapter 269 or to require
13 emergency backup power of greater duration.

14 (c) For purposes of this section, "telecommunications
15 carrier" has the same meaning as in section 269-1."



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 **"§269- Wireless telecommunications carriers; backup**
5 **power.** (a) As a condition for any certificate of public
6 convenience and necessity under section 269-7.5 for a wireless
7 telecommunications carrier the application shall demonstrate
8 that the carrier either:

9 (1) Owns, operates, or maintains infrastructure used for
10 the provision of telecommunications services in the
11 state and has the capability to maintain emergency
12 backup power for a minimum of twelve hours; or

13 (2) Does not own, operate, or maintain infrastructure used
14 for the provision of telecommunications services in
15 the state and obtains network access from a separate
16 utility that has established its capability to
17 maintain emergency backup power for a minimum of
18 twelve hours.

19 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit
20 the public utilities commission's authority to regulate wireless




1 telecommunications carriers under this chapter or to require
2 emergency backup power of greater duration."

3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5 begun before its effective date.

6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
