
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$67,824,750 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 seventh representative district, as follows:

7 1. Waiawa correctional facility
8 Design and construction for a new
9 visitor center to provide a safe,
10 functional, and welcoming space for
11 family members visiting inmates,
12 replacing the current makeshift
13 facility, which is a modified shipping
14 container.

16 Construction	\$1,500,000



1 non-functional dryers that currently
2 necessitate transporting laundry to
3 Halawa five days a week, including the
4 installation of commercial-grade
5 washers and dryers, along with
6 necessary appurtenances, to enhance
7 efficiency and meet the facility's
8 operational needs.

12 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
13 shall be expended by the department of corrections and
14 rehabilitation.

15 4. Waiawa correctional facility
16 Design and construction to remove and
17 replace boilers in inmate housing units
18 for Buildings 4, 5, 6, 9, and 10,
19 addressing the lack of hot water for
20 showers after work programs and
21 ensuring a functional and reliable hot



1 water supply, including necessary
2 appurtenances.
3 Design \$40,000
4 Construction \$400,000
5 Total funding \$440,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the department of corrections and
8 rehabilitation.

9 5. Waiawa correctional facility

10 Design and construction to replace the
11 roofs and gutters of Buildings 9 and
12 10, addressing persistent leaking
13 issues and ensuring long-term
14 durability as the existing roofs have
15 exceeded their 20-year life cycle.

17 Construction \$500,000
18 Total funding \$550,000

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
20 shall be expended by the department of corrections and
21 rehabilitation.



1 6. Kanoelani elementary school

2 Design and construction to replace
3 outdated campus fire alarm systems,
4 including the installation of a new
5 system monitoring infrastructure, to
6 enhance safety and ensure compliance
7 with modern fire safety standards.

8 Design \$500,000

9 Equipment \$2,000,000

10 Total funding \$2,500,000

11 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
12 shall be expended by the department of education.

13 7. Kanoelani elementary school

14 Design and construction to reroof
15 Building G, addressing wear and tear
16 and ensuring protection from weather-
17 related damage

18 Design \$25,000

19 Construction \$250,000

20 Total funding \$275,000

2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 8. Kanoelani elementary school
4 Design and construction to reroof the
5 administration building, addressing
6 wear and tear and ensuring protection
7 from weather-related damage.

13 9. Kipapa elementary school
14 Construction to implement various ADA-
15 compliance improvements across the

17 ensuring accessibility and inclusivity
18 for all students, staff, and visitors.

3 12. Kipapa elementary school

4 Design and construction to replace the
5 roofs of classrooms P-12 and P-13,
6 addressing weather-related wear and
7 tear to ensure a safe and functional
8 learning environment for students and
9 staff.

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13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 13. Mililani high school

16 Design and construction to remove and
17 replace aging portable classrooms with
18 permanent modular buildings designed
19 for 21st-century learning.

3 shall be expended by the department of education.

4 14. Mililani Mauka elementary school

5 Design and construction to replace
6 aging and inefficient air conditioning
7 equipment in Building A, improving
8 energy efficiency and ensuring a
9 comfortable learning environment for
10 students and staff.

11 Design \$90,000

12 Construction \$900,000

13 Total funding \$990,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 15. Mililani Mauka elementary school

17 Design and construction to replace
18 outdated campus fire alarm systems,
19 including the installation of a new
20 system monitoring infrastructure, to



1 enhance safety and ensure compliance
2 with modern fire safety standards.

3 Design \$500,000

4 Construction \$2,000,000

5 Total funding \$2,500,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the department of education.

8 16. Mililani middle school

9 Design and construction for an AgTech
10 classroom, storage facilities, and
11 parking, supporting the integration of
12 agricultural technology into the
13 curriculum and providing necessary
14 infrastructure for student learning and
15 activities.

16 Design \$600,000

17 Construction \$5,400,000

18 Total funding \$6,000,000

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
20 shall be expended by the department of education.

21 17. Mililani middle school



1 Design and construction to repair and
 2 resurface the deteriorating bus lanes
 3 and access road surfaces, improving
 4 safety and usability for students,
 5 staff, and vehicles accessing the
 6 campus.

 11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 18. Mililani middle school

13 Design and construction to replace the
 14 leaking roof, gutters, and soffits of
 15 Building E, addressing long-standing
 16 water damage and ensuring the
 17 building's structural integrity and
 18 functionality.

2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 19. Mililani middle school

4 Design and construction to widen the
5 sidewalks near Buildings F, G, and H to
6 meet ADA standards, create passing
7 spaces, and accommodate increased
8 pedestrian traffic from the new
9 Building J.

10 Design \$50,000
11 Construction \$700,000

12 Total funding \$750,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 20. Mililani Uka elementary school

16 Construction to implement various ADA-
17 compliance improvements across the
18 campus, including appurtenances,
19 ensuring accessibility and inclusivity
20 for all students, staff, and visitors.

19 Construction costs to relocate the
20 proposed Mililani high school teacher
21 workforce housing project from site A



1 to site B in response to community
 2 feedback, addressing the significant
 3 site grading and infrastructure
 4 development required to prepare the new
 5 location for housing construction.

10 25. Kamehameha highway

11 Plans, design, and construction for a
 12 barrier and signage along Kamehameha
 13 highway near the Kipapa gulch bridge to
 14 enhance public safety, prevent
 15 unauthorized encampments, and ensure
 16 unobstructed access to the highway.

2 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

3 26. Kamehameha highway
4 Plans, design, and construction to
5 resurface Kamehameha highway from
6 Waipahu street to Ka Uka boulevard to
7 address poor and cracking pavement
8 conditions, ensuring improved safety
9 and roadway durability.

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

16 27. university of Hawaii - west Oahu
17 Design and construction for a plaza and
18 central pathways to connect the
19 university of Hawaii - west Oahu to the
20 Keone'ae rail station, providing ADA-
21 compliant access and fostering safe,



1 efficient, and inclusive connectivity
2 for students, faculty, and visitors.

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the university of Hawaii.

8 28. university of Hawaii - west Oahu

9 Design and construction for
10 improvements to the exterior opening
11 doors and the installation of
12 additional CCTV systems at the
13 university of Hawaii - west Oahu to
14 enhance campus safety; improve security
15 measures along pathways to the rail
16 station; and provide a safer
17 environment for students, faculty, and
18 visitors.

1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the university of Hawaii.

3 29. university of Hawaii - west Oahu

4 Design and construction to repair and
5 reseal the exterior glass tower of the
6 university of Hawaii - west Oahu
7 library to address persistent water
8 leakage issues; protect the building's
9 structural integrity; and ensure a safe
10 and comfortable environment for
11 students, faculty, and visitors.

12 Design \$200,000

13 Construction \$2,000,000

14 Total funding \$2,200,000

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the university of Hawaii.

17 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
18 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
19 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
20 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
21 of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
