
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPORTS FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
3 appropriation under Act 88, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021,
4 section 26, as amended by section 5 of Act 248, Session Laws of
5 Hawaii 2022, in the amount indicated or balance thereof,
6 unallocated, allotted, encumbered, and unrequired, is hereby
7 lapsed:

10 SECTION 2. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
11 appropriation under Act 268, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019,
12 section 6, as amended by section 5 of Act 4, Session Laws of
13 Hawaii 2020, as amended by section 18 of Act 146, Session Laws
14 of Hawaii 2021, as amended by section 10 of Act 220, Session
15 Laws of Hawaii 2022, in the amount of \$20,000,000 of general
16 obligation bond funds or balance thereof, unallocated, allotted,
17 encumbered, and unrequired, is hereby lapsed.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Halawa
 2 redevelopment special fund, as renamed pursuant to section 8 of
 3 this Act, the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be
 4 necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 to be deposited into the
 5 general fund.

6 PART II

7 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue
 8 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
 9 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
 10 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
 11 for the purpose of upgrading the stadium on the university of
 12 Hawaii at Manoa campus to meet National Collegiate Athletic
 13 Association division I football stadium requirements, including
 14 plans, design, construction, equipment, appurtenances, ground
 15 and site improvements, infrastructure, and all related and
 16 associated project costs.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
 18 Hawaii for the purposes of this part.

19 SECTION 5. The appropriations made for the capital
 20 improvement project authorized by this part shall not lapse at
 21 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2027, shall lapse as of that date.

3 PART III

4 SECTION 6. Chapter 109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by amending its title to read as follows:

6 "CHAPTER 109

9 SECTION 7. Section 109-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "§109-2 ~~[Stadium]~~ Halawa redevelopment authority; powers
12 and duties. The powers and duties of the ~~[stadium]~~ Halawa
13 redevelopment authority shall be as follows:

14 (1) To repair, maintain, and operate ~~[stadium facilities~~
15 ~~and the stadium development]~~ the Halawa redevelopment
16 district, including:

17 (A) ~~[Repairs, maintenance, operations, and~~
18 ~~demolition]~~ Demolition of existing stadium
19 facilities;

20 ~~[-(B) Operations and maintenance of a new stadium;]~~ and



1 ~~[-(C)-]~~ (B) Contractual payments to developers,
2 contractors, or management contractors engaged by
3 the ~~[stadium]~~ Halawa redevelopment authority;

4 (2) To coordinate in planning, design, and construction
5 activities, including on-site repairs, within the
6 ~~[stadium development]~~ Halawa redevelopment district;

7 (3) To acquire and hold title to real property;

8 (4) To prescribe and collect rents, fees, and charges for
9 the use or enjoyment of the ~~[stadium, facilities~~
10 ~~related to the stadium,]~~ Halawa redevelopment
11 district, facilities related to the Halawa
12 redevelopment district, and real property held by the
13 ~~[stadium]~~ Halawa redevelopment authority, including
14 entering into leases, contracts, sponsorship and
15 advertising agreements, food and beverage agreements,
16 concession agreements, parking agreements, or other
17 development and use agreements that may apply;
18 provided that leases shall not exceed a term of
19 ninety-nine years;

20 (5) To make and execute contracts and other instruments
21 necessary or convenient to exercise its powers under



1 this chapter and subject to any limitations in this
2 chapter, to exercise all powers necessary, incidental,
3 or convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes
4 and provisions of this chapter;

5 (6) To adopt, amend, and repeal, in accordance with
6 chapter 91, rules it may deem necessary to effectuate
7 this chapter and in connection with its projects,
8 operations, and facilities;

9 (7) To appoint officers, agents, and employees, prescribe
10 their duties and qualifications, and fix their
11 salaries, without regard to chapters 76 and 89, to
12 manage the [~~stadium, the stadium development~~] Halawa
13 redevelopment district[7] and its contractors; and

14 (8) To plan, promote, and market the [~~stadium~~] Halawa
15 redevelopment district and related facilities."

16 SECTION 8. Section 109-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 "[+]§109-3.5[+] ~~Stadium development~~] Halawa redevelopment
19 **special fund; established.** (a) There is established in the
20 state treasury the [~~stadium development~~] Halawa redevelopment



1 special fund, into which funds collected by the [~~stadium~~] Halawa
2 redevelopment authority shall be deposited, including:

3 (1) All revenues from the [~~stadium-development~~] Halawa
4 redevelopment district, including but not limited to
5 agreements or actions generating revenue related to
6 [~~stadium~~] operations, lease or rental of facilities or
7 land, concessions, food and beverage, parking,
8 sponsorship and advertising, utilities and
9 infrastructure, and development;

10 (2) All gifts or grants awarded in any form from any
11 public agency or any other source for purposes of the
12 [~~stadium-development~~] Halawa redevelopment district;

13 (3) All proceeds from revenue bonds issued for the purpose
14 of the [~~stadium-development~~] Halawa redevelopment
15 district; and

16 (4) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.

17 (b) Moneys in the [~~stadium-development~~] Halawa
18 redevelopment special fund shall be used by the [~~stadium~~] Halawa
19 redevelopment authority for the payment of expenses arising from
20 any and all use, operation, repair, maintenance, alteration,
21 improvement, development, or any unforeseen or unplanned repairs

2 including without limitation[+:

3 ~~(1) The development, operation, and maintenance of a new~~

20 SECTION 9. Chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
21 amended by amending the title of part IX to read as follows:



1 ~~(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), all moneys collected~~
2 ~~by the stadium authority after June 30, 2021, shall be deposited~~
3 ~~into the stadium development special fund pursuant to section~~
4 ~~109-3.5.~~

5 ~~(c) Upon June 30, 2021, the stadium special fund~~
6 ~~established herein shall be abolished, and all appropriations,~~
7 ~~encumbrances, and the remaining unencumbered balance shall be~~
8 ~~transferred to the stadium development special fund."]~~

9 SECTION 11. Sections 40-84, 84-17(d), 109-1, 109-6, 109-7,
10 171-2, 171-64.7(a), 206E-221, 206E-222, 206E-223, 206E-224,
11 206E-225, 226-64, and 445-112, Hawaii Revised Statutes, are
12 amended by substituting the words "Halawa redevelopment
13 authority" wherever the words "stadium authority" appear, as the
14 context requires.

15 SECTION 12. Sections 109-1, 171-2, 201H-191.5, 206E-14,
16 206E-221, 206E-222, 206E-223(a), 206E-224, 206E-225, and
17 206E-226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting
18 the words "Halawa redevelopment district" wherever the words
19 "stadium development district" appear, as the context requires.

20 SECTION 13. Sections 36-27(a), 36-30(a), and 109-8, Hawaii
21 Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the words "Halawa



1 redevelopment special fund" wherever the words "stadium
2 development special fund" appear, as the context requires.

4 SECTION 14. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Sports Facilities; UH; Stadium Authority; New Stadium; GO Bonds; Lapse; Stadium Development Special Fund; Halawa Redevelopment; Appropriations

Description:

Lapses appropriations of general obligation bond funds previously authorized for the planning, design, and construction of a stadium in Halawa by the Stadium Authority. Transfers certain special fund moneys earmarked for the development of a new stadium in Halawa to the general fund. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds for a new stadium on the University of Hawaii at Manoa campus. Renames the Stadium Authority as the Halawa Redevelopment Authority and the Stadium Development District as the Halawa Redevelopment District. Amends the powers and duties of the Halawa Redevelopment Authority. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD3)
