# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. Section 132D-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 **"§132D-20 Enforcement; probable cause for arrest. (a)**

5 This chapter shall be enforced by the department of law  
6 enforcement or each county. The department of law enforcement  
7 and counties, or both, are authorized to enforce and administer  
8 the provisions of this chapter.

9 (b) Arrests for offenses under this chapter or under a  
10 county fireworks ordinance shall be made in compliance with  
11 chapter 803. The facts and circumstances to establish probable  
12 cause for an arrest may include but are not limited to:

13 (1) Statements from individuals who witnessed the offense,  
14 even if those individuals are not law enforcement  
15 officers; and

16 (2) Photographs, video recordings, or other recordings  
17 that show the commission of the offense and can be





1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the  
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year  
5 2026-2027 for the purchase of unmanned aerial vehicles to  
6 monitor the use of illegal fireworks.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
8 of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.

9 PART III

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

DLE; Fireworks; Unmanned Aerial Vehicles; Recordings; Probable Cause; Appropriation

**Description:**

PART I: Allows recordings made by law enforcement agencies who are using, controlling, or operating unmanned aerial vehicles to establish probable cause for arrests under the Fireworks Control Law if the unmanned aerial vehicle is recording directly above public property and the act leading to the arrest is committed on public property. PART II: Appropriates funds to the Department of Law Enforcement for the purchase of unmanned aerial vehicles to monitor the use of illegal fireworks. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
