
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§201- Native Hawaiian majority districts; designation.

5 (a) The department shall identify all legislative districts in
6 the State in which a majority of the population consists of
7 Native Hawaiians.

8 (b) Any district identified by the department pursuant to
9 subsection (a) shall be designated as a Native Hawaiian majority
10 district for purposes of representation and recognition."

11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
