
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342D-50.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~[+]§342D-50.5[+]—Treated]~~ Wastewater or raw sewage;

4 **prohibition.** (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the
5 contrary, no person, including any public body, shall discharge
6 any ~~[treated]~~ wastewater or raw sewage into state waters after
7 December 31, 2026; provided that this section shall not apply to
8 a ~~[sewage]~~ treatment plant that:

9 (1) ~~[Utilizes sewage to produce]~~ Produces clean energy
10 pursuant to section 196-10.5; ~~[and]~~

11 (2) Is in compliance with this chapter, rules adopted
12 pursuant to this chapter, or a permit or variance
13 issued by the director~~[-]~~; or

14 (3) Has a treatment capacity of less than ten million
15 gallons per day.

16 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to:



- 1 (1) Prohibit the use of reclaimed or recycled water for a
- 2 beneficial purpose as provided by law; or
- 3 (2) Allow the discharge of [~~treated~~] wastewater or raw
- 4 sewage into state waters in violation of any federal
- 5 statute, rule, or regulation."


6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8 begun before its effective date.

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
