
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS TO ESTABLISH
AN ANNUAL FESTIVAL CELEBRATING PACIFIC ISLAND CULTURE AND
ARTS.

1 WHEREAS, the 13th Festival of Pacific Arts and Culture
2 (FestPAC), hosted by Hawaii for the first time in its fifty-two-
3 year history in June 2024 attracted more than five hundred
4 thousand visitors and over two thousand two hundred delegates
5 from more than twenty-five island nations; and

7 WHEREAS, events like FestPAC promote trans-Pacific
8 cooperation and help preserve the strong cultural heritages of
9 Micronesia, Melanesia, and Polynesia; and

11 WHEREAS, providing annual dedicated opportunities to learn
12 about and experience the varied cultures and traditions that
13 make up the Pacific region will foster the bonds among these
14 peoples and allow for further understanding, cooperation, and
15 appreciation; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
19 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the State Foundation on
20 Culture and the Arts, in consultation with other agencies, is
21 urged to establish an annual festival in Hawaii that celebrates
22 the culture and arts of the Pacific region; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
25 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director
26 of the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts, Mayor of
27 the City and County of Honolulu, Executive Director of the
28 Honolulu Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts, and all members
29 of the Honolulu City Council.
