
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INITIATE A SUMMER
STREETS PILOT PROGRAM.

1 WHEREAS, streets and public spaces are invaluable resources
2 that can be adapted for multi-use purposes; and

4 WHEREAS, transforming streets and opening them up to
5 pedestrians, bicyclists, skateboarders, and other modes of
6 transportation aside from traditional motorized vehicles can
7 enhance community life by providing safe and inclusive
8 opportunities for recreation, active transportation, and
9 cultural engagement; and

11 WHEREAS, summer streets programs have been implemented
12 across the world for more than fifty years and have successfully
13 reimagined urban spaces and temporarily transformed streets and
14 roadways for all users; and

16 WHEREAS, summer streets programs encourage greater public
17 participation and physical activity while also bolstering local
18 businesses and improving environmental outcomes; and

20 WHEREAS, summer streets programs greatly align with the
21 State's goal of reducing carbon emissions and environmental
22 impact, encouraging sustainable transportation beyond car-
23 centric modes and promoting community health and belonging; now,
24 therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
27 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
28 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of
29 Honolulu is encouraged to initiate a summer streets pilot
30 program in the urban core of Honolulu, as well as in other
31 neighborhoods that want to realize these benefits; and
