
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGES,
INCLUDING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII MAUI COLLEGE, TO DEVELOP
A COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF BACHELOR'S, ASSOCIATE, CERTIFICATE,
AND OTHER EXISTING DEGREE PROGRAMS OR PATHWAYS THAT
DIRECTLY ALIGN WITH JOB OPPORTUNITIES AND INDUSTRY NEEDS
WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE REGION OF SERVICE.

1 WHEREAS, the State's economic vitality depends on a skilled
2 workforce that meets the needs of key regional industries,
3 including tourism and hospitality, agriculture, marine research,
4 renewable energy, and health care; and

6 WHEREAS, each of the University of Hawaii Community
7 Colleges plays a vital role in providing accessible,
8 regionally-relevant higher education that supports local
9 economic development; and

11 WHEREAS, aligning academic programs with current and
12 emerging job opportunities in each region will benefit students,
13 local employers, and the overall economic growth of the State;
14 now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
17 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
18 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the University of Hawaii
19 Community Colleges, including the University of Hawaii Maui
20 College, are requested to develop a comprehensive list of
21 Bachelor's, associate, certificate, and other existing degree
22 programs or pathways that directly align with job opportunities
23 and industry needs within their respective region of service;

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in developing the list, the
27 University of Hawaii Community Colleges, including the



1 University of Hawaii Maui College, are requested to evaluate the
2 regional economic drivers and their respective areas of strength
3 and align programming accordingly; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii
6 Community Colleges, including the University of Hawaii Maui
7 College, are requested to collaborate with local industry
8 leaders and stakeholders to ensure these programs are designed
9 in accordance with current labor market data and the specific
10 economic needs of each region; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the
14 University of Hawaii, Vice President for Community Colleges of
15 the University of Hawaii, and Chancellor of the University of
16 Hawaii Maui College.
