
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A TRAFFIC MITIGATION AND CALMING STUDY TO EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC MITIGATION AND CALMING DEVICES IN AND AROUND PAIWA STREET IN WAIPAHAU, OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of residents and
2 visitors in the City and County of Honolulu is of utmost
3 importance; and

4
5 WHEREAS, Paiwa Street in Waipahu, Oahu, is a heavily
6 trafficked thoroughfare that serves as a primary route for
7 residents, businesses, and schools in the surrounding area; and

9 WHEREAS, concerns have been raised by residents and
10 community members regarding excessive speeding, high traffic
11 volume, and increased risks to pedestrians, cyclists, and
12 motorists in and around Paiwa Street; and

13
14 WHEREAS, traffic mitigation and calming devices such as
15 speed bumps, raised crosswalks, red lights, and other applicable
16 mitigation utilities have been successfully implemented in
17 various locations to enhance road safety and reduce the
18 likelihood of traffic-related accidents; and

20 WHEREAS, a comprehensive traffic mitigation and calming
21 study would provide valuable insights into the most effective
22 strategies to improve safety and manage traffic flow in and
23 around Paiwa Street; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
27 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
28 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is

1 urged to conduct a traffic mitigation and calming study to
2 evaluate the effectiveness of speed bumps, raised crosswalks,
3 red lights, and any other applicable traffic mitigation
4 utilities for the areas in and around Paiwa Street in Waipahu,
5 Oahu; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
8 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu is
9 requested to submit a report of its findings and
10 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
11 Legislature prior to the convening of the Regular Session of
12 2026; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
15 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the
16 Department of Transportation Services of the City and County of
17 Honolulu.
