
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU,
HONOLULU CITY COUNCIL, AND DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND
RECREATION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CREATE A
DEDICATED ANIMAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING COMPLEX WITHIN
KALAELOA PARKLANDS.

1 WHEREAS, on June 12, 2024, the City and County of Honolulu
2 took ownership of approximately four hundred acres of designated
3 Kalaeloa parklands from the United States Navy; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu intends to use
6 these lands for public park and public recreational purposes;
7 and
8

9 WHEREAS, the needs of the animal community on Oahu have
10 been overlooked; and
11

12 WHEREAS, restrictions imposed on park usage at existing
13 City and County of Honolulu parks and competition for park usage
14 with sports groups have made it extremely difficult to find
15 suitable animal-friendly venues for dog shows, dog sports, cat
16 shows, bird shows, free flight bird areas, and 4H groups working
17 with animals; and
18

19 WHEREAS, Kapolei is a rapidly growing area, but its
20 residents lack a public park space to enjoy with their pets; and
21

22 WHEREAS, the only on-leash dog park within City Park
23 District 3, which covers Waipahu to Waianae, is the Ewa Beach
24 Community Park, and there are no public off-leash dog parks in
25 this area; and

1 WHEREAS, the Kalaeloa parklands are well situated to
 2 include an animal education and training complex; now,
 3 therefore,

4
 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 6 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
 7 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Mayor of the City and
 8 County of Honolulu, Honolulu City Council, and Department of
 9 Parks and Recreation of the City and County of Honolulu are
 10 requested to create a dedicated animal education and training
 11 complex within the Kalaeloa parklands; and

12
 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the dedicated animal education
 14 and training complex is requested to include bathrooms, secure
 15 indoor meeting and exhibition rooms similar to the McCoy
 16 Pavilion at Ala Moana Beach Park, food preparation facilities,
 17 and secure storage areas that may be rented by animal clubs to
 18 store necessary equipment, such as equipment for dog agility,
 19 dog obedience, and Fast CAT and cages required for benched cat,
 20 rabbit, and bird shows; and

 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
 24 and County of Honolulu, Chairperson of the Honolulu City
 25 Council, and Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation
 26 of the City and County of Honolulu.
