
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO REVIEW ALL
REPORTS REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGISLATURE AND
MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON WHICH REPORTS SHOULD BE
DISCONTINUED.

1 WHEREAS, reports to the Legislature can provide crucial
2 information and analysis to legislators and better inform them
3 on the initiatives of executive agencies and the Judiciary; and
4

5 WHEREAS, certain reporting requirements remain in statute
6 even though the reports may no longer be necessary for various
7 reasons, including that programs on which the reports are
8 focused no longer exist or that there is little to no new
9 information gathered between report submissions; and
10

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 23G-5, Hawaii Revised
12 Statutes, the Legislative Reference Bureau is tasked with
13 developing a system to track and monitor the submission of
14 reports to the Legislature by executive agencies and the
15 Judiciary; and
16

17 WHEREAS, the Legislative Reference Bureau can use this
18 system to help determine which reports to the Legislature should
19 be discontinued; now, therefore,
20

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
23 of 2025, that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to
24 review all reports required to be submitted to the Legislature
25 and make recommendations on which reports should be
26 discontinued; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference
29 Bureau is requested to submit a report of its findings and
30 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the


4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
