
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII STATE LEGISLATURE TO ESTABLISH A STATE
DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY.

1 WHEREAS, in a recent Harvard CAPS/Harris Poll seventy-seven
2 per cent of voters said a full examination of all government
3 expenditures is necessary; and
4

5 WHEREAS, in the same poll, eighty-three per cent of voters
6 favored reducing government expenditures over increasing taxes;
7 and
8

9 WHEREAS, state income tax cuts are projected to cost the
10 state of Hawaii \$5.6 billion in revenue by 2031, requiring an
11 unprecedentedly careful use of funds; and
12

13 WHEREAS, with a wide scope and scale of government
14 projects, it is vital that every taxpayer dollar is used
15 efficiently; and
16

17 WHEREAS, there have been countless instances of the state
18 government's inefficient use of funds in recent history, making
19 a department dedicated to investigating wasteful spending an
20 important, though currently neglected duty, to all Hawaii
21 taxpayers; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
24 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
25 of 2025, that the Hawaii State Legislature is urged to create a
26 State Department of Government Efficiency; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the Lieutenant
30 Governor, and members of the Thirty-third Legislature of the
31 State of Hawaii.
