
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE POSTMASTER GENERAL OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO RELOCATE THE PEARL CITY POST OFFICE TO THE UNITED STATES NAVY PROPERTY ON THE PEARL CITY PENINSULA.

1 WHEREAS, there are safety and traffic congestion concerns
2 regarding the customer entrance and exit driveway of the Pearl
3 City Post Office located on the northeast corner of Kamehameha
4 Highway and Acacia Road; and
5

6 WHEREAS, when the Pearl City Post Office was built in the
7 1970s, the road fronting it led to the United States Marine
8 Corps Manana housing and warehouse area and had very little
9 traffic towards the Kamehameha Highway intersection on the
10 United States Navy road; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the United States Navy eventually turned over the
13 majority of the Manana federal property to the City and County
14 of Honolulu on which the city developed Acacia Road and sold
15 property for business development for the Pearl Highlands area;
16 and

18 WHEREAS, with recent development of big box stores and two
19 shopping centers in the area, the Pearl City Post Office parking
20 lot has become extremely busy; and
21

22 WHEREAS, the Pearl City Post Office currently employs
23 seventy-five mail carriers and customer service and maintenance
24 employees, with a motor pool of seventy-five vehicles and
25 usually with forty vehicles operating on the road
26 simultaneously; and
27

28 WHEREAS, the Pearl City Post Office is at its maximum
29 spacial capacity to accommodate the increased need for postal
30 services in the area; and

32 WHEREAS, the Pearl City Post Office has a small lobby area
33 that only holds approximately six to ten people at a time for
34 customers both mailing and picking up packages; and

1 WHEREAS, the Pearl City Post Office has a few hundred post
2 office boxes for the public accessed outside of the building,
3 but has no room for expansion for larger cluster postal boxes;
4 and

6 WHEREAS, there has been a major increase in parcel post
7 packages due to more residents purchasing items online; and



9 WHEREAS, with the expected future transit-oriented
10 development around the Honolulu rail system station, the area
11 will experience further increase in residents; and

13 WHEREAS, moving the Pearl City Post Office from its current
14 location at the intersection of Kamehameha Highway and Acacia
15 Road to a larger, less-congested area will help mitigate some of
16 the public safety and traffic issues at that intersection and
17 alleviate the overcrowding of packages stored at the Post Office
18 warehouse; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
22 of 2025, that the Postmaster General of the United States Postal
23 Service is requested to build a new Pearl City Post Office on
24 federal, United States Navy property at the entrance area of the
25 United States Navy Pearl City Peninsula across from Lehua
26 Elementary School, allowing for a larger Post Office to be built
27 with a larger parking lot for employees and customers; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
30 Resolution be transmitted to the Postmaster General of the
31 United States Postal Service, Commander of Joint Base Pearl
32 Harbor-Hickam, and Governor.
