## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO DEVELOP AND RECOMMEND A  
PROCESS BY WHICH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS' SALARIES SHALL BE  
DETERMINED BY VOTERS.

1           WHEREAS, the United States of America and its individual  
2 states are designed to serve the people; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, by extension, government officials are servants of  
5 the people; and

6  
7           WHEREAS, government officials should be compensated for  
8 their work, but not in a manner that imposes an undue financial  
9 burden on taxpayers; and

10  
11           WHEREAS, to ensure that government officials are  
12 compensated in a manner that is consistent with the will of  
13 governed constituents, the governed constituents should have a  
14 direct say in the compensation of those officials; now,  
15 therefore,

17           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
18 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
19 of 2025, that the Attorney General is requested to develop and  
20 recommend a process by which government officials' salaries  
21 shall be determined by voters; and

23           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no later than twenty days prior  
24 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2026, the Attorney  
25 General is requested to submit to the Legislature a report of  
26 the Attorney General's recommendations, including any proposed  
27 legislation; and

2 Resolution be transmitted to the Attorney General and Chief  
3 Election Officer.
