# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII STATE HOSPITAL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$11,000,000 or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and  
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
5 year 2026-2027 for the adult mental health inpatient program  
6 (HTH 430/HQ) to secure contracts for the provision of forty  
7 psychiatric beds annually to the Hawaii state hospital.

8           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
9 of health for the purposes of this Act.

10          SECTION 2. Beginning with fiscal year 2027-2028 and each  
11 fiscal year thereafter, the department of health shall include  
12 in its annual budget request line-item funding for the adult  
13 mental health inpatient program (HTH 430/HQ) to secure contracts  
14 for the provision of psychiatric beds for the Hawaii state  
15 hospital. To ensure the continuation of support services, the  
16 amount of funding requested shall scale proportionally with the  
17 number of psychiatric beds provided.

**Report Title:**

DOH; Hawaii State Hospital; Adult Mental Health Inpatient Program; Line-Item Funding; Appropriations

**Description:**

Appropriates funds to the Department of Health for the Adult Mental Health Inpatient Program to secure contracts for the provision of forty psychiatric beds annually for the Hawaii State Hospital. Requires the Department of Health to include line-item funding for the Adult Mental Health Inpatient Program in its annual budget request beginning with fiscal year 2027-2028 to secure contracts for the provision of psychiatric beds for the Hawaii State Hospital.
