A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WARNING LABELS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§328- Carcinogenic foods and products; warning labels.

5 (a) Beginning July 1, 2027, any carcinogenic food or product
6 sold or distributed in the State shall have a warning label
7 affixed to the food or product that identifies any known risk of
8 cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm that may result from
9 exposure to the food or product.

10 (b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to
11 chapter 91 determining the format and contents of the labels
12 required by subsection (a).

13 (c) For the purposes of this section, "carcinogenic" means
14 that the food or product, or a chemical contained in the food or
15 product, has been classified as group 1 or group 2A by the World
16 Health Organization's International Agency for Research on
17 Cancer."



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2026-2027 for the implementation and enforcement of the warning
6 labels required by this Act.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8 of health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

Report Title:

DOH; WHO; IARC; Food Safety; Product Safety; Chemicals; Warning Labels

Description:

Requires, beginning 7/1/2027, any carcinogenic food or product sold or distributed in the State to include a warning label, in a format determined by the Department of Health. Defines "carcinogenic" as a food, product, or chemical classified as group 1 or group 2A by the World Health Organization's International Agency for Research on Cancer. Appropriates moneys.
