20 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 21 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



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1 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
2 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
3 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
5 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for the
6 purposes of this Act as follows:

7 (1) The sum appropriated in items 1 through 6 shall be
8 expended by the department of transportation;

9 (2) The sum appropriated in items 7 through 21 shall be
10 expended by the department of education; and

11 (3) The sum appropriated in item 22 shall be expended by
12 the department of health.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
