A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$35,310,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the eleventh
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. President Abraham Lincoln Elementary
8 School

9 A. Plans, design, and construction
10 for perimeter chain link fencing
11 for enhanced security near
12 Punchbowl abutting the National
13 Cemetery of the Pacific; equipment

1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
7 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended
8 for the purposes of this Act as follows:

9 (1) The sum appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
10 expended by the department of education; and

11 (2) The sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by
12 the department of land and natural resources.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
