
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING A BROADER RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE
STATE AND THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY.

1 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to
2 cultivate meaningful relationships with countries and
3 governments to collaborate on solutions to shared challenges;
4 and

6 WHEREAS, the State and the Kingdom of Norway share common
7 challenges as geographically distinct regions with unique
8 environmental, economic, and social concerns; and

10 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are deeply reliant on
11 their marine environments, with significant portions of their
12 economies and cultures tied to fisheries, aquaculture, and ocean
13 conservation; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Norway has developed one of the world's most
16 sustainable and technologically advanced fishing and aquaculture
17 industries, offering valuable insights that could benefit
18 Hawaii's ongoing efforts to enhance its local seafood production
19 and marine resource management; and

21 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are at the forefront of
22 renewable energy development, with Hawaii committed to achieving
23 one hundred percent renewable energy by 2045 and Norway being a
24 global leader in hydropower, offshore wind energy, and electric
25 transportation; and

27 WHEREAS, the State could benefit from Norway's expertise in
28 electric mobility, sustainable urban planning, and green energy
29 infrastructure, particularly in relation to integrating clean
30 energy into island-based economies; and

1 WHEREAS, the State could further benefit from Norway's
2 approach to prisons and criminal justice, as a subject of
3 conversation and collaboration; and

5 WHEREAS, tourism is a major economic driver for both Hawaii
6 and Norway, and the two regions can exchange best practices in
7 sustainable tourism management to balance economic growth with
8 environmental preservation; and

10 WHEREAS, Norway has a strong tradition of Arctic and marine
11 research that aligns with the State's research institutions'
12 focus on oceanography, climate change, and marine biodiversity,
13 creating opportunities for academic and scientific
14 collaboration; and

16 WHEREAS, Norway has established a robust social safety net
17 that provides comprehensive healthcare, education, and social
18 welfare programs, serving as a model for policies that support
19 quality of life and economic stability; and

21 WHEREAS, fostering a broader relationship between Hawaii
22 and Norway would enhance cross-cultural understanding,
23 facilitate economic and academic partnerships, and promote joint
24 initiatives in renewable energy, ocean conservation, and
25 sustainable development; now, therefore,

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third
28 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the
29 House of Representatives concurring, that this body supports and
30 encourages a broader relationship between the State and the
31 Kingdom of Norway; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
34 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and
35 Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.
