SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A PILOT PROGRAM IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS TO HAVE AVAILABLE STAFF TRAINED IN EPINEPHRINE ADMINISTRATION.

1 WHEREAS, anaphylaxis is a serious, life-threatening
2 condition that requires immediate treatment with epinephrine;
3 and

4
5 WHEREAS, quick access to and proper administration of
6 epinephrine can significantly improve health outcomes and save
7 lives; and

8
9 WHEREAS, students and staff at Department of Education
10 schools and charter schools suffer from life-threatening
11 allergies that require immediate epinephrine treatment when
12 exposed to the allergen; and

13
14 WHEREAS, having staff available at Department of Education
15 schools and charter schools who are trained in the proper
16 administration of epinephrine will increase the likelihood of
17 timely and appropriate treatment if a person suffers from
18 anaphylactic shock at school; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the
22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
23 Education is requested to establish a pilot program to make
24 available in each Department of Education school and charter
25 school, staff trained and authorized to administer epinephrine;

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, to the extent possible, the
29 Department of Education is requested to administer the pilot
30 program in the following manner:

- 1 (1) In each public school and charter school, placing a
- 2 minimum number of trained and authorized staff members
- 3 equal to the greater of one staff member per:
- 4
- 5 (A) One hundred students; or
- 6
- 7 (B) Floor or each school building to which students
- 8 have access; and
- 9
- 10 (2) Displaying in each public school and charter school
- 11 building clearly legible signs stating the symptoms of
- 12 anaphylaxis and the proper method for administering
- 13 epinephrine; and
- 14

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is

16 requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations

17 regarding the pilot program, including any proposed legislation,

18 to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the

19 convening of the Regular Session of 2026; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this

22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of

23 Education.
