# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A  
TIRE INVENTORY DATABASE.

1 WHEREAS, the abandonment of motor vehicle tires on private  
2 and public properties is prohibited, yet tires are still often  
3 illegally dumped; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, abandoned motor vehicle tires can provide a  
6 habitat for pests, be a fire hazard, and leach toxic chemicals  
7 into the environment; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, the State lacks a coordinated effort between the  
10 public and private spheres to track motor vehicle tires and hold  
11 owners liable for illegal abandonment; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that tire dumping in  
14 the State creates serious health and environmental concerns;  
15 now, therefore,  
16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third  
18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025,  
19 that the Department of Health is requested to work in  
20 partnership with motor vehicle tire retailers to collect  
21 information on purchased tires, and to establish and maintain  
22 the information in a database for a certain number of years; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the information collected in  
25 partnership with motor vehicle tire retailers include the model  
26 and serial number of each motor vehicle tire sold, purchaser's  
27 name, and date of the sale; and
